The **Renault Group Committee (RGC)** is the global body for social dialogue within the Renault Group.

31 members from 14 countries in which Renault is based sit on this body. They represent staff around the world in a balanced manner.

Action beyond **borders**

Present in **Europe and around the world**, the RGC **ensures respect for employees' rights** wherever the Renault Group is based. It acts in conjunction with international partners, including the **IndustriALL Global Union** and **IndustriALL Europe**, to protect high standards in employee representation and protection.

A source of pride: Global Framework Agreements for employees

Among its major achievements, the **RGC negotiated and implemented global framework agreements** for the benefit of Renault Group employees.

In particular, the **first Global Framework Agreement**, signed in **2013**, marks a common commitment to **social, societal and environmental responsibility**, laying the foundations for **sustainable growth and respect for social rights** in all Group locations.

Concrete support for **all employees**

Beyond the negotiation aspect, the RGC aims to be an essential mouthpiece for employees, in constant dialogue with the Group Management. Its objective is clear: to ensure that every Renault employee, regardless of their status or workplace, is aware of their rights and can assert them.

A day to day **commitment**

The RGC meets regularly to discuss and monitor the application of agreements and to discuss the major social issues facing the Renault Group.
